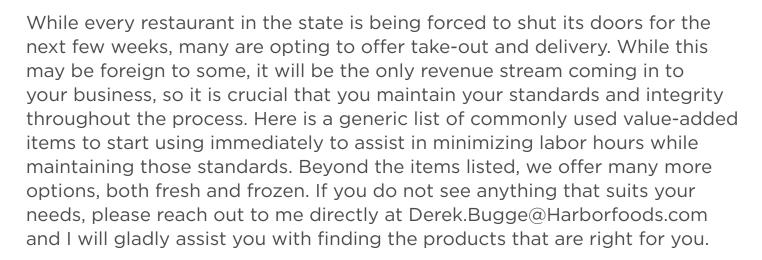


Utilizing value-added to counter labor shortage
