

2017 ESTATE RED MOUNTAIN MERLOT

The last 20 years have been interesting for Merlot. The simple truth is that there is *a lot* of lowish-quality Merlot in the marketplace, often produced en masse for grocery-store labels. If the goal is to ripen a lot of fruit in a so-so region inexpensively, Merlot (unfortunately) fits the bill.

But here's the thing. Those of us in the industry producing high-quality Merlot in high-quality regions were left holding the bag. The grape's reputation suffered; never mind that in Washington (and by extention, Red Mountain), Merlot is on the upper echelon of quality. Likewise, our peers in Napa, Bordeaux, and beyond continue to produce face-meltingly good Merlot. When we pour this wine in the tasting room, it is almost always our top seller. It's not uncommon to hear remarks like, "I didn't know Merlot tasted like that," or, "well this is a surprise!"

We're not surprised, because Merlot is delicious, suave, and sophisticated. We do not often use scores/accolades in our marketing, but it's worth noting that the previous version of this wine was one of Wine & Spirits' Top 100 Best Buys of 2019. Yay Merlot!
