

The Emorys are a 30+ year, multi-generational Red Mountain family. Having seen the success of viticulture in the region, they ripped out their apricot orchard and planted a Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard in the early 2000s. For a while, Kiona shared farming expertise and purchased all the fruit.

We formalized our relationship with the Emory family in 2018 by agreeing to a mutually beneficial long-term lease with a profit-sharing component. With that understanding came a branding update and the ability to graft most of the Emory Syrah plantings to Malbec to meet unfulfilled demand.

With that 2018 graft, our newly-christened Sunset Bench vineyard became our most significant source for Malbec, now the 5th most planted cultivar at Kiona (12.1 total acres). The higher-elevation site, nestled just south of Hightower and Tapteil vineyards, is ideal for Malbec. The wines have intense coloration and concentration, with a blue fruit propensity.
